LETTER CIRCULAR
NUMBER 09 YEAR 2021

ENFORCEMENT RESTRICTIONS ACTIVITIES PUBLIC (PPKM) EMERGENCY
CORONA VIRUS DISEASE 2019 IN ORDER OF LIFE ERA NEW
IN BALI PROVINCE

Based on:

1. Instwksi Minister In Country Number 15 Year 2021 about Defend#confession Restrictions Activities Public Emergency Corona *Virus Disease* 2019 In Region Java And Bali;
2. Rules governor Bali Number 10 Year 2021 about Application Discipline and Enforcement Law Protocol Health as Effort Prevention and Control *Corona VlrUs Disaase* 2019 in Order Life Era Smell; and
3. Letter Circular Governor of Bali No 3355 Year 2020 about Protocol Order Life Era New.

Concerned:

1. The more height transmission Covid-19 in region Province Bali moment this that be marked with more increase new case Covid-19 per day; and
2. The more important for all party for keep health, convenience, security, and safety for Public Bali.

Enforce provisions regarding the Enforcement of Emergency Community Activity Restrictions (PPKM) *Corona Virus Disease 2019* in the New Era of Life in the Province of Bali, as follows:

1. COVID-19 Emergency PPKl applies to 9 (nine) Regencies/Cities in Bali according to level 3 (three) criteria carried out by implementing the following activities:
 - a. the implementation of teaching and learning activities (Schools, Universities, Academies, and Education/Training Places) is carried out online;
 - b. the implementation of activities in the non-essential sector is applied 100 of (one hundred percent) Work From Home (WFH);
 - c. implementation of activities in the sector:
 - 1) essentials such as finance and banking, capital markets, payment systems, information and communication technology, non-COVID-19 quarantine handling hotels, export orientation industries are enforced by 50% (fifty percent) of maximum Work From Office (WFO) staff with strict health protocols;
 - 2) essential in the government sector that provides public services that cannot be delayed implementation is enforced 25% (twenty five percent) maximum install WFO with protocol strictly health;
 - 3) critical issues such as energy, health, security, logistics and transportation, food, beverage and supporting industries, petrochemicals, cement, national vital objects, disaster management, national strategic projects, construction, basic utilities (electricity and water), as well as industries meeting the basic needs of the community. daily 100% (one hundred percent) maximum of Work From Office (WFO) installation with strict health protocols;
 - 4) for supermarkets, traditional markets, grocery stores, and supermarkets that sell daily needs are limited to operating hours until 20.00 WITA with a visitor capacity of 50% (fifty percent); and
 - 5) for pharmacies and drug stores can be open for 24 hours.
 - d. implementation of eating/drinking activities in public places (restaurants, restaurants, cafes, traders street vendors, and hawker stalls) both in separate locations as well as those located in shopping centers/malls only accept takeaway delivery and do not accept dine-in (*dine-in*);
 - e. activities at shopping centers/mall/trade centers are temporarily closed unless access to restaurants, supermarkets, and supermarkets can be allowed with due observance of the provisions at point 1 point c.3 and point d;
 - f. implementation of construction activities (construction site and project site) operates 100% (one hundred percent) by implementing more stringent health protocols;
 - g. religious activities in places of worship (mosques, prayer rooms, churches, temples, SeLa . Temple and Temple other public places that are used as a place of worship) is carried out by involving a very limited number of people and with the permission of the Regency/City Covid-19 Task Force;
 - h. public facilities (public areas, public parks, public tourist attractions, and other public areas) are temporarily closed;
 - i. arts, culture, sports and social activities (locations for arts, culture, sports facilities and social activities that can cause crowds and crowds) are temporarily closed;
 - j. public transportation (public transportation, mass transportation, taxis (conventional and online), and rental/rental vehicle) is enforced with a maximum capacity setting of 70% (seventy percent) by implementing more stringent health protocols;
 - k. the wedding reception is attended by a maximum of 30 (thirty) people by implementing health protocols more strictly and do not apply to eat at the reception, the provision of food is only allowed in a closed place, and to take home;

- l. For those who travel by air transportation, they are required to show a vaccine card (at least 1 injection vaccine), a certificate of negative result of a PCR-based swab test no later than 2 x 24 hours before departure. Meanwhile, by land and sea transportation, you are required to show a vaccine card (at least 1 injection vaccine), a certificate of negative results from a PCR-based swab test or a negative result of the Rapid Antigen Test no later than 2 x 24 hours before departure. Drivers of logistics and other goods transportation vehicles are exempt from the requirement to have a vaccine card;
 - m. To show the accuracy and ensure the authenticity of the negative results of the PCR-based swab test or the negative results of the Rapid Antigen Test, the information letter must be accompanied by Barcode QR Code; and
 - n. keep wearing masks correctly and consistently when executing activities outside the home, and the use of face shields without wearing a mask is not permitted.
2. Carry out tightening activities and education with the following principles:
- a. Covid-19 is most contagious in closed conditions, long meetings (more than 15 minutes), close-range interactions, crowds, activities with strong breathing such as singing, talking, laughing and not wearing masks such as when eating together;
 - b. the correct and consistent use of masks is the minimum health protocol that everyone should apply;
 - c. washing hands with soap or hand sanitizer repeatedly, especially after touching objects touched by other people (such as doorknobs or stair railings), touching the face area with hands should be avoided;
 - d. the better type of mask, the more protective (for example, disposable surgical masks are better than cloth masks, and N95 masks are better than surgical masks). Currently, the use of masks as much as two layers is a good choice. Masks should need to be changed after use (more than 4 hours);
 - e. the application of health protocols is carried out by considering air ventilation factors, duration, and interaction distance, to minimize the risk of transmission in activities;
 - f. distance considerations can be applied as follows:
 - 1) work from home only, and interact only with people who live in the same house;
 - 2) if you have to leave the house, you must always strive for a minimum distance of 2 (two) meters in interacting with other people. Reduce/avoid contact with other people who do not live in the same household; and
 - 3) disseminate various visual instructions in public places regarding prevention and handling Covid-19,
 - g. duration considerations can be applied as follows:
 - 1) if you have to interact with other people or attend an activity, do it for a short duration to reduce the risk of transmission; and
 - 2) In office and other activity situations, scheduling and rotation can help to reduce interaction duration,
 - h. consideration ventilation can be applied as follows:
 - 1) outdoor activities have a much lower risk of transmission than indoors in imagination; and
 - 2) the room should always be endeavored to have good air ventilation. Opening doors, windows can be done to reduce the risk of transmission. In the condition that the door or window cannot be opened, the purifier air with High Efficiency Particulate Air (HEPA) filter can be used indoors,
 - i. in conditions of widespread transmission in the community, more stringent interventions with significantly limiting community mobility needs to be done;

j. 3T reinforcement (Testing, Tracing, Treatment) needs to be continuously applied:

- 1) *testing* need to be increased according to the weekly positivity rate, with the following conditions:

Weekly positivity rate	Number of bags (per 1000 residents per Week)
<5%	1
5-15%	5
15-25%	10
>25%	15

Testing continues to be improved with a target positivity rate of <10% (ten pennies); testing needs to be improved on suspects, namely those with symptoms, as well as close contacts. The target people tested per day for each district-city are as follows:



- 2) *tracing* is done until there are more than 15 close contacts per confirmed case. Quarantine is carried out on those identified as close contacts. Once identified, close contacts should be checked (entry-test) and quarantine should be carried out. If the test result is positive, then you need to be isolated. If the test result is negative, then quarantine is necessary. On the 5th day of quarantine, it is necessary to do a re-examination (exit-test) to see if the virus is detected after/during the incubation period. If negative, then the patient is deemed to have completed quarantine; and
 - 3) *treatment* is carried out comprehensively according to the severity of the symptoms. Only patients with moderate, severe, and critical symptoms need to be hospitalized. Isolation needs to be done strictly to prevent transmission
- k. Efforts to accelerate vaccination continue to be carried out to protect as many people as possible and this effort is carried out to reduce the rate of transmission and prioritize the safety of those who are vulnerable to death (such as the elderly, people with comorbidities) given the limited health capacity and long-term impact of Covid-19 infection.
3. Regents and Mayors to accelerate the process of distributing social assistance and social safety nets sourced from the APBD, if there is a need for additional funding for budgeting and distribution of social assistance and social safety nets in supporting the implementation of PPKM Daurat Covid-19 is guided by Inmendagri Number 15 of 2021 in the EIGHT DIKTUM.
 4. Funding for the Implementation of Emergency PPKM due to the Covid-19 Pandemic, which comes from the APBD is guided by the Minister of Home Affairs Number 15 of 2021 in the NINE DIKTUM.
 5. In the event that the Regent and Mayor do not implement the provisions in number 1, number 2, and number 3, they will be subject to administrative sanctions in the form of written warnings twice in a row up to temporary dismissal as stipulated in Article 68 paragraph (1) and paragraph (2) of the Law. Law Number 23 of 2014 concerning Regional Government.

6. For businesses, restaurants, shopping centers/mall/trade centers, transportation common ones does not carry out the provisions as stipulated in point 1 points c, d, e, and j above, will be subject to administrative sanctions up to business closure in accordance with the provisions of the legislation.
7. Every person, business actor, manager, organizer or person in charge of public places and facilities who carry out activities, is obliged to carry out the health protocols that have been determined, namely: implementing a healthy and Covid-19-free lifestyle with 6 M: Wearing standard masks correctly, washing hands, keep distance, reduce travel, increase immunity, and obey the rules;
8. Everyone should limit activities outside the home and try to delay/reduce travel outside the area, especially those in the red zone category.
9. All parties are reminded to be more serious, orderly, disciplined, and fully responsible for complying with the following provisions:
 - a. Bali Governor Regulation Number 10 of 2021 concerning the Implementation of Discipline and Enforcement Health Protocol Law as an Effort to Prevent and Control Corona 11TUS Disease 2019 in the New Era of Life Orders; and
 - b. Circular Letter of the Governor of Bali Number 3355 of 2020 concerning Protocols for the Order of the New Era of Life.
10. Airport, Port and Land Transportation Operators to regulate and tighten the implementation of procedures and inspection of PPDN travel requirements, including regulating the availability of human resources and equipment, as well as providing daily reports to the Bali Province COVID-19 Handling Task Force. Especially for the Ketapang-Gilimanuk ferry port, training is carried out supervision test results for PPDN, by placing joint checkpoints coordinated by Port Health Office (KKP), facilitated by PT. ASDP Indonesia Ferry.
11. To Peöekel/Lurah synergize with *village custom* so that:
 - a. to immediately establish a Task Force for Handling Covid-19 Based on Traditional Villages with an organizational structure, tasks, and functions as regulated in the Governor's Joint Decree Bali and the Bali Province Traditional Village Council on the Establishment of a Mutual Cooperation Task Force for Handling Covid-19 on the basis of Traditional Villages in Bali;
 - b. before the Task Force for Handling Covid-19 Based on Traditional Villages was established, the implementation of the Village/Kelurahan-Based PPKM was handled by Village/Kelurahan Volunteers and the Task Force for Covid-19 Prevention Based on Traditional Villages in Bali; and
 - c. activate Command Post (Posko) Mutual Cooperation Prevention Covid-19 based on Traditional Villages in Bali as a forum for the activities of the Gotong Royong Task Force as referred to in letter a;
 - d. implementation as referred to in huof c, specifically for Village level Command Posts may stipulate or make changes to regulations in the form of village regulations, regulations village head and village head decisions.
12. To the Regents/Mayors throughout Bali to form a Mutual Cooperation Command Post (Posko) for the Handling of Covid-19 in the District led by the Camat for supervision and reporting of the Village/Kelurahan Command Post.
13. To the Regents of 3 Nalikota throughout Bali to carry out intensive inspections of PPDN using National Ports and Roads by activating checkpoints that synergize with TNI/Polri officers at regional borders to ensure implementation health protocols and travel requirements for PPDN.

14. Needs financing in implementation Posts Mutual cooperation Handling Covid-19 level Village/Urban charged on budget each element corresponding with tree needs as following:
 - a. needs in level Village charged on Fund Village and can be supported from source income Village more via APBDes;
 - b. needs in level village charged on APBD Regency/City;
 - c. needs in level Village custom charged on Budget Income and Shopping Village Customs;
 - d. needs related Babinsa/Bhabinkamtibmas charged on Budget TNI/Polri; and
 - e. needs related strengthening *testing*, *tracing*, and *treatment* charged on Budget Ministry Health or BNPB, APBD Universe Planned Province Bali/District/City.
15. To Commander Kodam IXUdayana, Police Chief Area Bali, Head Unit Police civil servant Soldier Province Bali and *Pacalang* Village Custom, so that To do operation enforcement discipline that lebih intensive, massive, and firm use ensure the implementation of the Circular this fault effective.
16. Circular this start be#me on the day Saturday (*Saniscara Kliwon, Uye*), date 3 July 2021 to with Tuesday (*Budget paing, Bala*) 20 July 2021.
17. With Circular's account this, Letter Circular governor Bali Number 08 Year 2021 about Extension Defend#confession Restrictions Activities Public Based on Village/Village In Order Life Era New In Province Bali is revoked and stated not be#me.
