### CIRCULAR LETTER NUMBER 11 YEAR 2021

about

#### PEPIBERLAKUAN RESTRICTIONS ON IYIASYARAKAT ACTIVITIES (PPKM) LEVEL 3 *CORONA VIRUS DISEASE* 2019 IN THE NEW ERA OF LIFE ORDER IN BALI PROVINCE

1. Instruction of the Minister of Home Affairs No. 22 of 2021 concerning the Enforcement of Restrictions on Community Activities Level 4 *Corona Virus Disease* 2019 In Java And Bali;
2. Bali Governor Regulation No. 10 of 2021 concerning The Application of Discipline and Law Enforcement of Health Protocols as An Effort to Prevent and Control *Corona Virus Disease* 2019 in the Life Order of the Bars Era; and
3. Circular Letter of the Governor of Bali Number 3355 year 2020 on The Protocol of New Era Life Order.

watch:

1. The increasing transmission of Covid-19 in the province of Bali today is characterized by the increasing number of new cases of Covid-19 peitan; and
2. Increasingly important for all parties to maintain health, comfort, security, and safety for the people of Bali.

Enacting provisions on **the** Enforcement of Community Activities (PPKM) Level 3 Corona *firms Disease* 2019 In **The** Life Order Of Bars Era In **Bali** Province, as follows:

1. PPKM in 9 (nine) regencies / cities in Bali with criteria level 3 (three) is carried out by applying the following activities:
  - a. The implementation of teaching and learning activities (Schools, Colleges, Academies, and Places of Education / Training) is conducted online,'
  - b. implementation of qiatan in the sector:
    - 1) Essentials such as:
      - a) Finance and banking only include insurance, banks, pawnshops, pension funds, and financing institutions (which are oriented towards physical services with customers (*custorrie*) can operate with a maximum capacity of 50% (fifty) percent of staff for locations related to services to the community, as well as 25% (twenty-five) percent for office administration services to support operations;
      - b) Capital market (service oriented with *{custorrie* and beqalannya capital market operations well) can operate with a maximum capacity of 50% (fifty) percent of staff;
      - c) Info«riasi and communication technology includes mobile operators, data centers, internet, postal, media related to the dissemination of information to the public can operate with a maximum capacity of 50% (fifty) percent of staff;
      - d) Non-quarantine handling hospitality can operate with a maximum capacity of 50% (fifty) percent of staff; and
      - e) Export orientation industry where the company must show proof of example documents Of Export Of Goods (PEB) documents for the last 12 (twelve) months or other documents showing export plans and must have an Operational Permit and Mobility of Industrial Activities (IOMKI) can operate with a maximum capacity of 50% (fifty) percent of staff only in production facilities / factories, and 10% (ten) percent for office administration services to support operations.
    - 2) Essential to the government sector that provides public services that cannot be delayed implementation is enforced 25% (twenty-five percent) maximum WFO staff with strict health protocols;
    - 3) Activities in the non-essential sector (other than numbers 1) and 2) above), can operate with employees / employees bekeqa in the office / shop / stall as much as 25% (twenty-five percent), prefer tranksaksi on / irie, by applying a very strict health protocol and limited operating hours until 21.00 WITA.
    - 4) Critical as:
      - a) Health can operate 100% (one hundred) percent of staff without exception;
      - b) Security and public order can operate 100% / (one hundred) percent of staff without exception;
      - c) Disaster management can operate 100% / (one hundred) percent maximum staff, only in production facilities / constrksi / services to the community and for office administration services to support operations, imposed a maximum of 25% (twenty-five) percent of staff;
      - d) Energy can operate 100% (one hundred) percent maximum staff, only in production/construction facilities/services to the community and for administrative services to support operations, a maximum of 25% (twenty-five) staff person is applied;
      - e) Logistics, transpotasi and distribution especially for basic needs of the community can operate 100% / (one hundred) percent maximum staff, only in production facilities / construction / services to the community and for office administration services to support operations, imposed a maximum of 25% (twenty-five) percent of staff;

- f) Food and beverages and their support, including for temas/pets can operate 100% (one hundred) percent maximum staff, only in production/construction/service facilities to the community and for office administration services to support operations, a maximum of 25% (twenty-five) percent of staff are applied;
  - g) Fertilizer and petrochemicals can operate 100% (one hundred) percent maximum staff, only in production facilities / construction / services to the community and for office administration services to support operations, imposed a maximum of 25% (twenty-five) percent of staff;
  - h) Cement and building materials can operate 100% (one hundred) percent maximum staff, only in production/construction/service facilities to the community and for office administration services to support operations, a maximum of 25% (twenty-five) percent of staff are applied;
  - i) National vital objects can operate 100% (one hundred) percent maximum staff, only in production / construction facilities / services to the community and for administrative services offices to support operations, a maximum of 25% (twenty-five) percent of staff;
  - j) National strategic projects can operate 100% (one hundred) percent maximum staff, only in production facilities / construction / services to the community and for administrative services offices to support operations, a maximum of 25% (twenty-five) percent of staff;
  - k) Construction (public infrastructure) can operate 100% (one hundred) percent maximum staff, only in production facilities / construction / services to the community and for office administration services to support operations, imposed a maximum of 25% (twenty-five) percent of staff;
  - l) Basic utilities (electricity, water and waste management) can operate 100% (one hundred) percent maximum staff, only in production facilities / construction / services to the community and for office administration services to support operations, enforced a maximum of 25% (twenty-five) percent of staff.
- 5) For supermarkets, traditional markets, grocery stores, and supermarkets that sell daily needs are limited to operating hours until 21.00 WITA with capacity 50% (fifty percent), and
  - 6) For pharmacies and drugstores can be open for 24 (twenty-four) hours by implementing strict health protocols.
- c. The implementation of food / drink activities in public places (food stalls, restaurants, cafes, street vendors, and hawker stalls) both in their own location and those in shopping centers / malls only accept delivery / take away and do not accept dine-ins are limited to operating hours until 21.00 WITA,
  - d. Activities in shopping centers / malls / trade centers are closed as long as except access to restaurants, supermarkets, and supermarkets can be allowed by hiring 50% (fifty percent) staff, with strict health protocols and prioritize delivery / take away services.
  - e. Implementation of construction activities for public infrastructure (construction sites and project sites) operate 100% (one hundred percent) by implementing stricter health protocols,
  - f. Religious activities in places of worship (Mosques, Mosques, Churches, Temples, Temples, and Temples and other public places that function as places of worship) wherever possible do not hold worship be#amaah, or carried out by involving a very limited number of people and with the permission of task force Covid-19 District / City;
  - g Public facilities (public areas, public parks, PUBLIC attractions, and other public areas) are closed while
  - h. Arts, cultural, sports and social activities (art locations, culture, sports facilities and social activities that can cause crowds and crowds) are temporarily closed,

- i. Public transportation (public transportation, mass transportation, laksi (conventional and *online*), and rental vehicles) are implemented with a maximum capacity setting of 70% (seventy percent) by applying health protocols more strictly;
  - j. The implementation of the wedding reception is abolished during the implementation of emergency pphkm;
  - k. For those who do the qalanan with air transportation must show karlu vaccine (minimum injectable vaccine 1), certificate of negative results of PCR-based swab test no later than 2 x 24 hours before departure. While by land and sea transportation must show a vaccine card (minimum injectable vaccine 1), a certificate of negative results of PCR-based swab test or negative results of *Rapid Test Antigen* test no later than 2 x 24 hours before departure. For drivers of vehicle logistics and transportation of other goods are excluded and the provision of having a vaccine card;
  - l. To show accuracy and ensure the authenticity of negative results of PCR-based swab tests or negative results of *Aapid Tesf Antigen* tests, the certificate must be equipped with Barcode/QRCode; and
  - m. Keep wearing the mask properly and consistently when carrying out activities outside the home, serfa not allowed to use *tace shield* without the use of masks.
2. Implementing the tightening of activities and education with the following principles:
- a. Covid-19 is most contagious in closed conditions, long meetings (more than 15 minutes), close interactions, crowds, activities with strong breathing such as bemyanyi, talking, laughing and not wearing masks as when eating together;
  - b. Proper and consistent use of masks is the minimum health protocol should be applied to everyone;
  - c. Washing your hands with soap or *hand sanitizer* repeatedly especially after touching objects that others touch (such as door handles or ladder handles), touching the face area by hand needs to be avoided;
  - d. Better type of mask, alan more protective (for example disposable surgical mask more both of the cloth mask, and the N95 mask is better than the surgical mask). Currently, the use of a two-layer mask is a good choice. Masks should be replaced after use (more than 4 hours);
  - e. The application of health protocols is carried out taking into account the factors of air ventilation, duration, and distance of interaction, to minimize the risk of transmission in activities;
  - f. Distance considerations can be applied as follows:
    - 1) Do activities from home only, and interact only with people who live in the house;
    - 2) If you have to leave the house, you should always try to get at least 2 (two) meters in interacting with others. Reduce/avoid cortical with others who do not live in the house; and
    - 3) Socializing various visual instructions in public places related to the prevention and handling of Covid-19,
  - g. Duration considerations can be applied as follows:
    - 1) If you need to interact with others or attend an activity, it is done by a short duration to reduce the risk of transmission; and
    - 2) In other activities and situations, scheduling and rotation can help to reduce the duration of interactions,
  - h. Ventilation pertirnbangan can be applied as follows:
    - 1) Outdoor activities have a much lower risk of transmission than indoors; and
    - 2) The room should always be attempted to have good air ventilation. Opening the door, a window can be done to reduce the risk of transmission. In the condition that the door or window cannot be opened, then *the water castle /ler* with *High Efficiency Particulate Air* (HEPA) filter can be used indoors,

- i. In the case of widespread transmission in the community, stricter interventions by limiting the mobility of the community are significantly necessary;
- j. Strengthening 3T (*Testing, Tracing, Treatment*) need to be continuously applied:
  - 1) *Testing* needs to be improved according to the post rate "itiv"/ weekly rate, with the following conditions:

*Testing* needs to be continuously improved with *positiv targets* "ity rate <10% (ten percent); *testing* needs to be continuously improved against suspek, i.e. those with symptoms, **as well as** **close** contact. Target people are tested per day for each district following the following table:



- 2) *Tracing* is carried out until it reaches more than 15 close contacts per confirmation case. Quarantine needs to be carried out on those identified as close contacts. Once identified close contact should be checked immediately (entry-fesf) and **quarantine** needs to be carried out. If the test result is positive then it is necessary to do isolation. If the result of torture is negative then it is necessary to continue quarantine. On the 5th day of quarantine, an exif-/esf is required to see if the virus is detected after/during the incubation period. If negative, the patient's raka is considered to have finished quarantine; and
  - 3) *Treatment* needs to be done comprehensively according to the severity of the symptoms. Only moderate, severe, and critically symptomatic patients need to be hospitalized. isolation needs to be done strictly to prevent transmission
- k. Efforts to accelerate vaccination **must** continue to protect **as many** people as possible and these efforts are made to reduce **the rate of** transmission **and** prioritize **the safety** of those **who** are vulnerable to **death** (such as the elderly, people with comorbid) in view of limited **health capacity** and **the** long-term impact of Covid-19 infection.
3. Regents and Mayors to speed up the process of distributing social assistance and social safety nets sourced from APBD, if there is an additional need for funding for budgeting and distribution of social assistance and social safety net in support of the implementation of PPKM Level 3 Covid-19 guided by Inmendagri No. 22 of 2021 in the EIGHTH DIKTUM
  4. Funding for the Implementation of PPKM Level 3 due to the Covid-19 Pandemic sourced from APBD guided by the Inmendagn No. 22 of 2021 in the DICTUM KESENBILAN
  5. In the event that the Regent and Mayor do not implement the provisions on the numbers 1, number 2, and number 3, are subject to sanctions as stipulated in Article 67 to Article 78 of Law No. 23 of 2014 on Local Government.

6. For businesses, restaurants, shopping centers / mall / trade centers, public transportation that does not implement the provisions as stipulated in the numbers 1 points b, c, d, and i above, subject to administrative sanctions until the closure of the business in accordance with the flexibility of the legislation.
7. Every Person, Business Person, Manager, Organizer or Person in Charge of Public Places and Facilities who carry out activities, is obliged to carry out established health protocols, namely: implementing a healthy and Covid-19-free lifestyle with 6 M: Wearing a standard mask correctly, Washing hands, keeping distance, Reducing travel, Improving immunity, and Obeying the rules;
8. Everyone to limit activities outside the home and try to delay / reduce the peqalanan out of the area, especially the red zone category area.
9. All parties are reminded to be more earnest, orderly, disciplined, and full of responsibility to **comply** with the following provisions:
  - a. Bali Governor Regulation No. 10 of 2021 concerning the Application of Discipline and Law Enforcement of Health Protocols as An Effort to Prevent and Control *Corona Virus Disease* 2019 in the New Era Of Life Order; and
  - b. Circular Letter of the Governor of Bali Number 3355 year 2020 on Protocol of Life Order era new.
10. Airport, Port, and Land Transportation operators to regulate and tighten the implementation of the probes and torture requirements of PPDN, to regulate the availability of human resources and equipment, and provide daily reports to the Task Force handling COVID-19 Bali Province. Specifically, Ketapang-Gilimanuk crossing port was tightened supervision of test results for PPDN, with the installation of a joint checkpoint coididinir by the Port Health Office (KKP), facilitated by PT. ASDP Indonesia Ferry.
11. To Perbekel / Lurah synergize with *Bandes* Adat so that:
  - a. Immediately activate the Task Force Gotong Royong Handling Covid-19 Based On Indigenous Villages in accordance with the stipulated in the Joint Decision of the Governor of Bali and the Bali Provincial Indigenous Village Assembly on the Establishment of Task Force Gotong Royong Handling Covid-19 Based Indigenous Villages in Bali;
  - b. The implementation of Village/Village Based PPKM is handled by Village/Village Volunteers and Gotong Royong Task Force on Covid-19 Prevention based on Indigenous Villages in Bali; and
  - c. Activate The Gotong Royong Covid-19 Prevention Command Post based on Indigenous Villages in Bali as a forum for gotong royong task force activities as referred to in letter a;
  - d. The implementation as referred to in letter c, specifically for Village Level Post can determine or make regulatory changes in the form of Village regulations, village head regulations and village head decisions.
12. To the Regent / \ / Yali city in Bali to activate the Command Post (Posko) Gotong-Royong Handling Covid-19 District led by the Sub-District for supervisi and reporting post at the village / village level.
13. To the Regent / Walikota se-Bali to conduct intensive checks on PPDN using ports and national roads by activating checkpoints that synergize with TNI / Police officers at the border of the region to ensure the implementation of health protocols and requirements for ppdn.
14. Financing needs in the implementation of Post Gotong-Royong Handling Covid-19 village / village level is charged to the budget of each element in accordance with the basic needs as follows:
  - a. Village-level needs are charged to village funds and can be supported from other village revenue sources through APBDes;
  - b. Needs at the Village level are charged to the District/City Budget;

- c. Needs at the Indigenous Village level are charged to the Indigenous Village Budget;
  - d. Babinsa/Bhabinkamtibmas related needs are charged to the TNI/Polri Budget; and
  - e. The need related to strengthening *testing, tracing, and treatent* is charged to the Budget of the Ministry of Health or BNPB, Budget Semesta Rencana Bali Province / Regency / City.
15. To Commander Kodam IX/Udayana, Bali Regional Police Chief, Head of Pamong Praja Police Unit of Bali Province and *Pacalang* Desa Adat, to conduct more intensive, massive, and decisive disciplinary enforcement operations to ensure the implementation of this circular effectively.
  16. This circular is effective on Wednesday (*Buda Pon, Bala*), from July 21, 2021 to Sunday (*Red"ite Pairig, Ijgu*) 25 July 2021.
  17. With the difference of this Circular, Circular Letter of the Governor of Bali Number 09 Year 2021 Concerning the Enforcement of Restrictions on Community Activities (PPKM) Emergency *Corona Virus Disease 2019* In the New Era Of Life Order In Bali Province, Circular Letter of the Governor of Bali Number 9R Year 2021 On Affirmation of Operational Hours Limit and Circular Letter of the Governor of Bali Number 10 Year 2021 Concerning The Second Amendment of Circular Letter Governor of Bali Number 09 Year 2021 On The Enforcement of Restrictions on Community Activities (PPKM) Emergency *Corona Virus Disease 2019* In the New Era Life Order In Bali Province, revoked and declared invalid.
